If Evening Land is outwardly defined by one wine, it is La Source Pinot Noir. The 2017 La Source Pinot Noir is the standout wine of the vintage. Grown at the rocky and windy crest of the vineyard, this wine communicates a sense of place more faithfully and more forthrightly than any wine we make.

TASTING NOTE

The 2017 La Source Pinot Noir is most representative of the vintage with brilliant color in the glass and aromatic purity on the nose. We are bullish on this wine's ageability. The elevated acidity in the vintage and the structure attained through partial whole-cluster fermentation position this wine to enjoy a long arc in the cellar.
