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The 2015 Seven Springs Blanc de Blancs is Evening Land's first sparkling wine. Sourced entirely from Block 9 at our Seven Springs Estate Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills, this traditional, méthode champenois, sparkling wine was fermented and raised in neutral barrels. After 7 months the wine was racked to bottle and began a 31-month tirage.

The label is a microscopic photograph of silica tetrahedrons, the mother material of our weathering volcanic, basalt clay soils here in the Eola-Amity Hills. Like our still wines, the 2015 Blanc de Blancs is a wine of place, faithfully communicating the rocky, volcanic soils of Seven Springs Vineyard.
