### VINEYARD

The Seven Springs Chenin Blanc comes from just 1.1 acres of vines that were grafted to Chenin in the winter of 2016. Originally planted as own-rooted Wadenswil clone Pinot Noir, these vines line the southern border of the vineyard, hugging a forestline of Douglas fir and growing in iron-rich basalt soil

### TASTING NOTE

A historically dry vintage, the 2018 Chenin Blanc ripened fully and developed into a textural, food-friendly wine we knew this site was capable of producing.

In terms of style, this Chenin Blanc is bone dry and fiercely reductive. Our volcanic soils yield wines that are flinty, very taut, high in acidity and freshness, with the ability to age for a very long time.
